Hematologic Management

- Use of transfusions
- Iron overload
- Frequency of monitoring

The Adult with Fanconi Anemia

- Adult diagnosed in childhood
 - Ongoing medical issues
 - Hormonal issues/metabolic syndrome
 - Iron management
 - Hepatic/renal/cardiac status - polypharmacy
 - New medical issues
 - Vascular and bone health
 - Breast imaging
 - Sexual functioning/fertility
 - Malignancy
 - Unknown
 - Cardiac and vascular
